"The **Scottish Network** is offering a one-year discipleship programme giving men and women of all ages and backgrounds, the opportunity to encounter God's passion for humanity. It will not only transform who you are as a person, but it will equip you with the skills required to impact your world. The course runs each week during term time. Each session includes teaching, worship, discussion and ministry. Seeking the presence of God is at the very heart of the programme and we give time to learning how to hear from Him, pray and receive words of encouragement and blessing for others.

This year, for the first time, we are offering IGNITE Scotland as a hybrid online and in-person programme. Most sessions will be hosted via Zoom with three opportunities to meet up in-person during the year."

The programme looks amazing and covers so many topics with a good balance of teaching and practice. It would be great to have a group doing this together so that we can encourage each other along the way.

Little Stars - 2.5 years to Pre-school - in Youth Café area

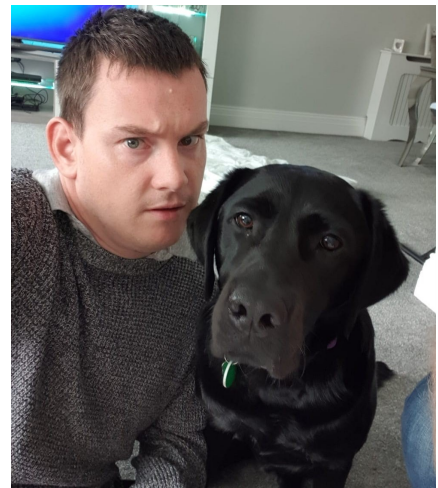
BCC Kids - Primary 1 to Primary 6 - in the Small Hall

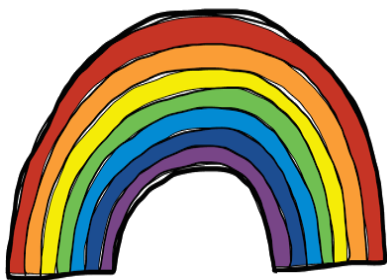
